And so this does leave me with a problem because I would like to have both of us along with some supporters of the bill, of course, Senator Vickers will from that district, but I guess at this point I am not going to press it. I will withdraw the motion.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Nelson, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR NELSON: How about a compromise on that with the Education, Revenue, and three from each Congressional District?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, I will tell you what...excuse me. We don't have anything before us at the moment, Senator Nelson, so there is nothing to talk about. He withdrew the bill, the motion, I mean. Thank you. It looks like...

CLERK: Mr. President, while we are waiting, Senator Goodrich would like to add his name to 662 as co-introducer; Senator Higgins to 404 as co-introducer.

SPEAKER NICHOL: No objections, so ordered. Do you have anything else, Mr. Clerk, to read in while we are reading in?

CLERK: I don't think so.

SPEAKER NICHOL: While we are waiting, you have been asking what we are going to do the rest of the afternoon. We have Senator Rupp's Final Reading bill that we passed over this morning. We would like to do that as soon as we are through with 662, and several are starting to fade away and so we will have a look at it as soon as we are through with Senator Rupp's bill. Do you have something else, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, no sir. The next item I have is reading LB 569.

SPEAKER NICHOL: No, don't you have an amendment on 662? No, we are going to stay on...well, it is on Final Reading, isn't it, so there is nothing to do. Thank you. Yes, we are ready to go to Senator Rupp's bill. Would you please, ladies and gentlemen, (gavel), ladies and gentlemen, (gavel), gentlemen in the back, (gavel), I must have your
