SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, I rise to support the committee amendments but would also at this time like to introduce an amendment to the committee amendments. And with that amendment, what I would like to do is...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Just a minute, Senator, we are on an amendment to the committee amendments. Is this a different one?

SENATOR CONWAY: This is a different one.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well...

SENATOR CONWAY: I will come back and speak to that after you have addressed this. Is that how you want to do that?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Are you going to introduce another amendment to the committee amendments?

SENATOR CONWAY: Yes, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, Senator Hefner, do you know if this amendment is the same as yours or a different amendment to the committee amendments? It is a different one?

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. Speaker...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, we will have to take Senator Hefner's first, Senator Conway, and then we will take up your committee amendment to the amendment. Okay? Senator Labedz, did you wish to speak to the present...all right. Senator Hefner, did you want to close about the amendment to the committee amendment that you are on?

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, just a point of clarification. I think that we will need to adopt my amendment to the committee amendment and then after that, well, then we will take Senator Conway's.
