

pickle sales. It doesn't affect the percentage that goes to the state. It doesn't affect the pay-out percentages. The only place it would affect, it would shift it into the profitability area that goes with those organizations who sponsor these particular pickle cards and they are willing to give up 2 percent of their profit to allow for a more smoother running operation and to continue to allow those people to sell those cards for them and they think it is well in their best interest to allow this. So that is my closing.
