people will have time to be aware that this is in the law, it will not take effect, this particular provision, until January 1, 1986. So I'm asking that you return the bill and attach the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Schmit, please.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, Senator Chambers has a good amendment here. I agreed to it. I think it might be a very beneficial amendment, in fact, because of the new idea of utilization of methanol as an alcohol for mixture with gasoline. There have been some problems with the use of methanol, which is directly opposed to use of ethanol. So the identification, which Senator Chambers provides in this manner, should perhaps, I believe will in fact, remove any doubt as to whether or not the petroleum companies are using methanol or ethanol, and should prevent some problems that might otherwise develop for the motorist. So I support the amendment and ask you to return the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the explanation. The question is, shall the bill be returned for a specific amendment? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is returned. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I move the adoption of the amendment.
