CLERK: Nothing at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we'll go back to 407 with the emergency clause on it, for reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read bill on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Two are excused. Have you all voted that care to? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1523-24 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 11 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 407 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 407A with the emergency clause attached.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read bill on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 407A pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Thirty-three votes required to pass. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1524-25 of the Legislative Journal.) 35 ayes, 9 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 407A passes with the emergency clause attached. We'll move on to Select File, but before we do, I'd like to introduce some guests of ours. In the south balcony Senator Hoagland has 51 fourth grade students from Underwood-Oakdale School in Omaha, accompanied by their teachers. Would you please stand and be recognized. Thank you.
