

Mr. Clerk, do you have something to read into the file?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would like to print amendments to 662, and Senator DeCamp to 216. (See page 1525 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, there will be an Executive Session of the Health and Welfare Committee underneath the north balcony now, Health and Welfare, north balcony, right now.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first item I have on 183 are E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have is by Senator Hefner. Senator Hefner would move to amend the bill. The amendment is on page 1407 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I move my amendment to LB 183. This is a technical amendment. Earlier I passed out an explanation to you of it. It is a technical amendment recommended by the Bill Drafter's Office. The problem that we are having is that the language merely refers to such license. It does not refer to what license. So this amendment amends that and refers to a license to sell alcoholic liquor at retail. I move my amendment to the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion? If not, the question is the adoption of the Hefner amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of the Hefner amendment. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.
