

SENATOR DECAMP: I call the question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. You were the last one. Senator Lundy, do you wish to close please?

SENATOR LUNDY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I just ask the body to consider the proposition that has been outlined for them here. I think wine and beer is presently allowed to be sold, as Senator DeCamp indicates, it is a local option. We are attempting to prohibit the sale of hard liquor from noon until 6:00 p.m. on Sundays. That is all the amendment does. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Lundy amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Three are excused, Senator Lundy. Senator Lundy.

SENATOR LUNDY: Mr. Speaker, I'd ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote, please.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the house is under call. Please return to your desks and record your presence. Those outside the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Please record your presence when you come in. Several of you are at your desks. Would you please record your presence. Looking for Senator Chambers, Senator Chronister, Senator Goodrich, Senator Hall, Senator Peterson, Senator Smith, Senator Wesely and Senator Withem. Please return to the Chamber so we can continue. Thank you. Senator Vard Johnson, Senator Hartnett and Senator Chizek are excused. Others should be here, please. when you come in, please record your presence so we'll know you are here. Senator Withem. Senator Withem, record your presence, please. Thank you. Looking for Senator Goodrich. Senator Lundy, we have everybody but Senator Goodrich. Should we continue?

SENATOR LUNDY: I wonder if you wouldn't proceed with the roll call vote, please.
