

department does not know about them, then those tanks would fall under the provisions of LB 383. They would be required to get the registration and they would have the penalty applied to them, which I think is proper and just. So with the adoption of this amendment you would be catching those tanks that are not being regulated now and probably put a great encouragement for some of those that may not be being regulated to, in fact, notify the Fire Marshall's Office and fall under the regulations under 81-502. I have visited with Senator Abboud about this. I think that it meets with his approval. But I would certainly hope that he would speak to that. Again, Mr. President, I would ask for the adoption of this amendment to LB 383.
