

puts on every package of cigarettes, these can be harmful to your health, let us put into this bill a disclaimer for the Legislature. I'm serious and I'm asking that the bill be brought back.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to return the bill to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 19 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Next, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to return the bill for a specific amendment. Senator, this is the one I have labelled number 2 which strikes all of subsection 2 to Section 5.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, at the time I offered these amendments, we had the bill before us so I'm going to call your attention to the place in the Final Reading copy that this amendment would deal with. If you turn to page 3 of your bill and look in lines 17 through 20, starting at the end of the line in 17 you'll see a 2 in parenthesis. I want to strike all of the language beginning with that (2) through all of the language through line 20 and I'm going to read the language. This is talking about exemptions. "A rural letter carrier of the United States Postal Service while performing his or her duties as a rural letter carrier between the first and last delivery points." When we got our instructions the other day, members of the Legislature, from that handout given by the American Automobile Manufacturers Association they told us what we could do, how much fine we had to put on the bill and so forth, they said that you were allowed to give an exemption for health reasons. They didn't say anything about exempting employees of the federal government. Isn't that hypocritical? I'm sorry, Senator Morehead, but I've got to use the words that express what I have on my mind. Here the federal government is ordering people in Nebraska to wear these seat belts, then it is exempting its employees. Why exempt an employee of the
