

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I move adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Very well, the motion is to adopt the amendment and we will take a machine vote. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 13 nays on adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails. The amendment is adopted. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I move that LB 496 be readvanced, and I would like a machine vote.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance the bill from Select File to Enrollment and Review for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Machine vote requested. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 9 nays on the motion to readvance LB 496, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is readvanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have to the bill. Senator Pirsch, I understand the amendment you had in the Journal, Senator, you want to withdraw and substitute, is that right?

PRESIDENT: Yes, with no objection, Senator Pirsch may withdraw and substitute an amendment and do you want to read the amendment, Mr. Clerk, or what?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Pirsch would move to amend the bill. (Read Pirsch amendment as found on page 1553 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Pirsch.
