

PRESIDENT: I will ask the Clerk to record it.

SENATOR DECAMP: Okay.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call and we are also under Final Reading. Members will please record your presence and we will determine by the board who is here and are not here. Senator Nelson, please. Senator Marsh is here. Senator Johnson. Senator Schmit. There are 10 members excused at the present time, so it appears that we have everybody present. SPEAKER NICHOL: Changing from yes to not voting for purpose of reconsideration.

CLERK: Senator Nichol changing from yes to not voting. 18 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Senator DeCamp, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR DECAMP: This sounds silly but I move the call be raised. Then what happens?

PRESIDENT: The motion...because we are going to take a vote on it.

SENATOR DECAMP: On...okay. Okay, forget it. We will just hang loose.

PRESIDENT: The motion is withdrawn. All right, what next, Mr. Clerk?
