PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Labeledz and then Senator Pappas.

My grandchildren at least call him the "ding ding" man and I wish the Lieutenant Governor would ring the bell twice because then we would designate that the man coming down the street is an ice cream man. He does not get out of his vehicle. He turns around, opens up the back compartment and delivers a Popsicle and he never leaves the vehicle. So I am assuming, Senator Hefner, that he would be included because he is making deliveries on the block and he never gets out of the car. He just turns around and for the record I want that in there, that he will not be included.

SENATOR HEFNER: Senator Labeledz, I believe that he would be covered if he does not exit from his vehicle.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you. So now we have another group that would be exempt from the law. I also would like to ask Senator Morehead one more question because I may vote for this amendment. Senator Morehead.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: I think you already did vote for it a minute ago.

SENATOR LABEDZ: I voted to return the bill because I wanted to make sure that I asked that question that they were included.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Yes, Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: If you are caught driving or a front seat passenger without a seat belt, you are charged with a traffic infraction?
