

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion is to adopt the Hefner amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are presumed to be on...we are on Final Reading and presume that unexcused members are all here. The Chair will allow 15 seconds for the recording of your vote on the adoption of the Hefner amendment. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: I would like to have a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Roll call vote has been requested.

SENATOR HEFNER: We are under call, is that correct?

PRESIDENT: We are under Final Reading, Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay.

PRESIDENT: By the rules of the Legislature...by your rules every member is to be in his seat during the times you are on Final Reading. Proceed. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, we are actually on Select File. We are not on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: That's true. That's true.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So I would ask for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT: Okay. We are back to where we were. The motion is to call the house. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

All members of the Legislature outside the Chamber who might be hearing my voice, please return to the Chamber for recording your presence. The house is under call.
