

been, by the way, a very healthy clarification of the rationale for the bill but that is why that language is there. Now I don't have to live with that language. If you want to put it in and we find that we can live with it...we can take out on Select File if there is no problem with it, but I understood that I was addressing the kinds of concerns that were brought to the Banking Committee when this bill was taken to them and the kind of claims that were made about the practices of defendants, and for that reason, that kind of provision was framed. I would urge the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Landis amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. There are nine excused. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Since we were just under call, I won't ask for a renewal of the call. Let's move to a roll call vote and dispense with the amendment one way or the other.

SPEAKER NICHOL: A roll call vote has been asked for. Mr. Clerk. We are voting on the adoption of the Landis amendments.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1562-63 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is not adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp, did you want to speak about the bill or not?

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, I want to pray. How many are excused?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Nine.

SENATOR DECAMP: Nine?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, nine.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, if we were not to vote on it right now, when will we take it up again?
