SENATOR HABERMAN: To your knowledge, has an interim study ever been refused that has been introduced by a committee or a senator?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Haberman, years ago when you and I were first in the Legislature there was an attempt to set up a process by which some were refused and some were taken and that didn't turn out to be very workable because everybody wanted to get their input into what was most important so we're not saying we're refusing any. We're saying that some of them we're going to pick out to focus resources on and the others we're going to refer to the committees and the committees will have to make decisions about what resources they want to expend on those resolutions.

SENATOR HABERMAN: When you talk about resources you're talking about money?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Haberman, talking primarily staff time and that's money too, but it...

SENATOR HABERMAN: Okay, I think you'll be fair and up front about it so I'm not going to worry about it. Thank you, Senator Beutler.
