

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson would move to amend the committee amendments. (Johnson amendment appears on page 1594 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vard Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, this is an amendment that's almost an embarrassment to carry. My aide, Eric Will, who has the eyes of a hawk, told me that one "and" should be an "or" and that's because the numbers of people on the special committee have been reduced from 14 to seven so I am making the "and" the "or".

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the amendment to the committee amendments? If not, the question is the adoption of the Vard Johnson amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. You are voting on the adoption of the Vard Johnson amendment to the committee amendments. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment to the committee amendments. (See page 1594 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Vard Johnson amendment to the committee amendments is adopted. Senator Haberman, did you wish to speak to the committee amendments?

SENATOR HABERMAN: On the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Any further discussion on the committee amendments? Senator Wesely, did you wish to close?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker. I'd just ask adoption for them. Again, the major change is to cut down the number of the members of the committee. That should save some money so I'd ask your support for it.
