Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence and I understand you authorized call in votes. And we are voting on the advancement of LB 201A.

CLERK: Senator Chronister voting yes. Senator Hoagland voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk, please. A roll call vote has been asked for. Well, we have enough now and if we authorized call ins, then as soon as we get enough we should proceed, so go ahead with your roll call vote. Oh, do you want to wait until everybody comes in? You are entitled to that, Senator Vard Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Well, I think that there were more here before I had the call of the house than right this moment, at least to have checked in, so I'd like to at least get these folks to check in. Then we'll...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Do you want to wait until everybody has checked in?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Then we can honor Senator Haberman's capricious request.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we're looking for Senator Goodrich. Five are excused. Senator Remmers, would you check in, please. Thank you. Senator Marsh. Thank you. Proceed with the roll call vote. We're voting on the advancement of the A bill.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 1594-95 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill advances and the call is raised. Do you have anything to read in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Not now, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We will move on to 439.
