

the receipt shall show the date and the time of day the grain dealer loaded the truck and the name and address of the buyer, the name of the seller, the name of the agent, the motor vehicle license plate number of the vehicle which is used to haul the grain, kind of grain and approximate quantity of grain. And also on this form will be the provisions of Section 6 of this act which in effect warns the farmer that he has ten, ten and ten. He has ten days to request payment from the grain dealer. He has ten days to cash the check and then he has ten days to appeal to the Public Service Commission if the check bounces. So this is just an attempt to put a little more burden on the grain dealer because it is easy for them to come and go and make them a little bit more responsible. I would ask that the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Haberman, on the Lamb amendment.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, members of the body, it's a friendly amendment and I ask that the body accept it.
