CLERK: 21 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator DeCamp's amendment to the committee amendments. (See page 1598 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: The DeCamp amendment is adopted. Now we're back to the committee amendments. Senator Landis, did you wish to move those, the committee amendments?

SENATOR LANDIS: (Mike not turned on immediately.) ...as amended.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall the committee amendments be adopted as amended? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments to the bill, Mr. President.
