LB 606, 633, 709

PRESIDENT: Quorum present. (Gavel.) The Legislature is in session. Senator Rogers has guests in the south balcony today. They are 45 eighth grade students, and 24 German exchange students from Centura School in Boelus, Dannebrog and Cairo, accompanied by their sponsors. If you'd all stand we are very happy for your decision to come down to see the Legislature today and we'd like to welcome you. Quorum present. We are going on Select File. Do you have any matters for the record at this time?

CLERK: Mr. President, one item. Senator Vickers has amendments to be printed to LB 633 in the Journal. That is all that I have. (See pages 1618-21 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Hall in the area for our Select File matters? Thank you, Senator. I believe we are ready then for LB 709.

CLERK: Mr. President, 709, I have E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further, Senator.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that LB 709 be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 606.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first item I have on 606, the E & R amendments, excuse me, have been adopted. I now have pending an amendment from Senator DeCamp to the bill. That amendment is on page 1582 of the Journal.
