PRESIDENT: Thank you. Is there further discussion on the resolution? If not, the motion is to adopt the resolution as introduced and explained by Senator Hartnett. All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. Please record your vote on LR 92, please. Please record your vote on LR 92. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 92.

PRESIDENT: The resolution is adopted. And we welcome you, Colonel Donley and your accompanying staff to the Legislature. Be watchful over Senator Hartnett today. The Chair would like to announce that Senator Nichol has guests in the south balcony. They are 7 students and 5 adults from Lake Minatare School in Scotts Bluff County. And Senator Rupp has 13 seventh and eighth graders in the south balcony. They are from District 84 School in Platte Center, Nebraska, accompanied by their teacher. And we are very happy that you came over today to watch the Legislature and if you would all stand, we would like to recognize you. We proceed into Final Reading now when all members are in your seats. When all members are in your seats we will proceed with Final Reading. All right, we will proceed now with Final Reading on LB 272. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 1648 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

CLERK: (Read LB 272A on Final Reading.)
