

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I'll move for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT: Very well. A call of the house has been suggested. The question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.
