CLERK: Senator Rod Johnson voting yes. Senator Morehead voting yes. Senator Lynch voting yes. Senator Baack voting yes. Senator Conway voting yes. Senator Beyer voting yes. Senator Peterson voting yes. Senator Barrett voting yes.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to cease debate and you may call in your votes to the Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Hefner voting yes.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. All members return to the Legislature. Please indicate your presence, Senators. The house is under call. Also you may call in your vote to the Clerk. The motion is to cease debate on the question offered by Senator DeCamp of placing 231 on General File.

CLERK: Senator Vard Johnson voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Members may call in your vote to the Clerk. Senator Haberman.

CLERK: Senator Haberman voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 5 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails. The debate is ceased. The call of the house is raised and the Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp for closing. The motion is to place 231 on General File notwithstanding committee action of indefinite postponement. Senator DeCamp.
