CLERK: Senator Vard Johnson voting yes. Senator Goll voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Members may call in your vote to the Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Baack voting yes. Senator Pappas voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Schmit, we missed your vote, but the amendment is passed and the call of the house is raised.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I believe the issue has been thoroughly debated and discussed and the amendment is the bill. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion is to advance LB 608 from General File to Enrollment and Review. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 608.

PRESIDENT: LB 608 is advanced. The next one we take up is LB 102.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 102 was a bill that was introduced by Senators DeCamp, Schmit, Beyer and Lamb. (Read title.) The bill was first read on January 10 of this year. It was referred to the Public Works Committee for hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Public Works Committee amendments pending.
