SENATOR VICKERS: Yes, I will withdraw that amendment, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I believe, Mr. President, I have nothing further to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: So now we have the committee amendments as amended. Senator Schmit, would you handle the committee amendments as amended now. Excuse me, I'm sorry, they are Barrett's amendments. All right. Senator Barrett.

SENATOR BARRETT: Mr. President, I think they were described earlier before the Vickers amendment but once again reiterating that it did remove earlier before the Vickers amendment the common carrier, redefines hazardous materials and provided a delayed operative date until January 1st of 1986. I move the committee amendments be adopted as amended.

PRESIDENT: Senator Higgins, do you wish to speak on the committee amendments? Okay. Any discussion on the committee amendments? If not, the motion is to adopt the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.
