CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Beutler, just want to renew your motion.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Is this for closing, Mr. Speaker? Yes, I would renew the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 518 and it is debatable. Is there any discussion? If not, the motion is to advance LB 518. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion is to advance LB 518 from General File. Please record your vote. May we have your cooperation on the motion before the house. The motion is to advance LB 518. May we have the cooperation of members outside the Chamber and in the Chamber for your attention here on this motion so we may expedite our proceedings. The motion is to advance LB 518. Please vote. We need the assistance of somebody to vote aye or nay on the motion to advance LB 518. Please record your vote. May we have the attention of members who might be in the rotunda. We need some assistance in here. The motion is to advance LB 518. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 518.

PRESIDENT: LB 518 is advanced. LB 633.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I might right before that...

PRESIDENT: Very well.

CLERK: Senator Goodrich has amendments to 273 to be printed. A new A bill by Senator Beutler, 367A. (Read for the first time by title.) And I have a report of Registered Lobbyists for the week of April 12 through April 18. (See pages 1695-96 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, LB 633 was a bill that was introduced by the Education Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was first read on January 22, referred to the Education Committee, advanced to General File. There are Education Committee amendments, Mr. President.
