CLERK: Mr. President, if I might, the first request I have from Senator Warner is for the introduction of Request #1097.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes the Chairman of the Appropriations Committee, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the motion. Request 1097 is the deficiency bill. There will be six bills to be introduced so it will take six separate votes, as I understand it. Request 1097.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the motion by Senator Warner to introduce a bill, 1097? If not, the motion is to introduce the bill. Thirty votes are required. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. May we have your cooperation on Senator Warner's motion to introduce LB 1097, please. Have you all voted? Senator Hannibal.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Mr. President, a point of clarification, for introduction of bills, we will need 30 votes for each of these, isn't that correct?

PRESIDENT: That is correct.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: I just want to let the body know that we need 30 votes for the introduction.

PRESIDENT: Thirty votes are required and we would ask for cooperation of the membership to accomplish this purpose today. May we have your attention to Senator Warner's motion and may we have your vote on his motion for the introduction of a new bill pertaining to appropriations. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk. The Chair would request that you stick around so that we may accomplish these next two motions the same way, hurriedly.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to introduce Request 1097, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails, the bill is introduced. Next request.
