LB 347, 347A, 383

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 347 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1722-23 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 347 is declared passed. Next is LB 347A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Final Reading of LB 347A.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 347A pass? All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1723-24 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 347A is declared passed. Next is LB 383.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Very well.

CLERK: Senators Hannibal and Marsh would move to return 383 to Select File for specific amendment. That amendment is on page 1625 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hannibal, you going to...Thank you. Senator Hannibal.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this amendment that we are offering to LB 383, we are asking right now to have the bill pulled back from Final Reading so we might attach the amendment, and if you recall the discussion a couple of weeks ago that Senator Marsh had an amendment that was going to be attached to LB 383, or she was attempting to.
