

bring it back.

PRESIDENT: That is right. The Clerk makes the point that we are not at a time now where we can consider the division. We are now on the motion to return. The specific amendment that might be considered on Select File, if the bill is returned, is not divisible.

SENATOR VICKERS: Once it gets back to be adopted, but at this point in time is the amendment divisible?

PRESIDENT: Well, it's not before us.

SENATOR VICKERS: We have not brought it back yet, so we are not really debating it at this point.

PRESIDENT: I know. You are asking two things. You are asking an anticipatory question. Presently, we are on the motion to return to Select File for the specific amendment. The Clerk advises that if and when the bill is returned to Select File for the specific amendment, the specific amendment is not divisible.

SENATOR VICKERS: Well, I would like to try an amendment up there to strike Section 3 from this amendment since I think it is divisible since we haven't brought it back yet.

PRESIDENT: Well, at the time we bring it back you are asking me if it is divisible when it is brought back. I am advised that it is not. You can make it in a separate motion.

SENATOR VICKERS: In any case I'll make a separate motion then to bring it back again to strike this section, if we do adopt this amendment.

PRESIDENT: That would be the procedure.

SENATOR VICKERS: Okay. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President, members, I rise to oppose bringing the bill back for the specific amendment. I think we have a bill here that has had a public hearing, and that has gone through the channels, and that this is certainly
