PRESIDENT: All right. Anything else on 383, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir.

PRESIDENT: All right. We will return to Final Reading,  
which we are on anyway, for reading of LB 383. Every member  
in your seat. All members in your seats, we are on Final  
Reading. Proceed.

CLERK: (Final Reading of LB 383.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure  
having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 383  
pass? All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. Have  
you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote,  
Mr. Clerk.
