PRESIDENT: Thanks, Senator Chambers. Anyone else wish to speak on the motion? Any closing? Motion is to return the bill to Select File for specific amendment. All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. Please record your vote. The motion by Senator Landis is to return LB 413 to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on Senator Landis's motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails. We are on Select File. Senator Landis, do you want to formally offer your motion?

SENATOR LANDIS: (Response inaudible.)

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendment that has been under discussion, offered by Senator Landis. Anyone wish to discuss it? If not, all those in favor of adopting the motion...the amendment vote yes, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Do I hear, Senator Landis, your motion to readvance the bill?

SENATOR LANDIS: (Response inaudible.)

PRESIDENT: All right. Motion is to readvance the bill. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is readvanced to Enrollment and Review for engrossment. Another amendment on the desk...motion.
