SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I think this resolution goes a little further than the sponsors are talking about. It goes...and we have to consider the word "freedom" and what is freedom, and that is what we have is freedom. This country has always had freedom but there are some members of this body who have never lost their freedom and, therefore, they do not understand or do they know what it means not to be free. Now I lost my freedom during World War II in the service. My first night in the barracks, when they blew the whistle the next morning to get up, I was a smart aleck high school kid and I wasn't going to get out of bed. Two minutes later I was laying on the floor from the top bunk. The sergeant had taken me and the mattress and I was laying on the floor and he says, I want to tell you something, private, the next time those lights come on and you hear the whistle, you get up and do what you are supposed to. So for approximately three years I lost my freedom. And this is what we have in this country is freedom. To keep that freedom we have to be strong militarilywise, defense and offense. We have got to have it because Russia is going to do everything they can to take our freedom away from us. Look at the countries who they have taken their freedom from. Now this resolution and what they are trying to do is a little bit like a football game. Let's say that Russia is ahead 28 for Russia and 7 for Nebraska. So they decide at the half to change the rules. We are going to change the rules of this football game. Touchdowns are only going to count 3 points. We are not going to allow any field goals and we are going to have one pass per quarter. That is all you can have. Not only that, we are going to cut the time of each quarter exactly in half. That is what this resolution does, because Russia is way, way ahead of us and they are going to stay that way
