PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...the tragedies of others that have an effect on us even if we were not directly and personally touched by it. The vote on this resolution gives each of us the opportunity to show where we stand on a matter such as this and I am going to tell you all something. I believe before it is over the President is going to cancel that visit. Then remember what Senator DeCamp said, remember what Senator Hefner said, about this being a matter that we should just leave alone and allow everybody to be painted with the brush that the President would have us painted by. He is not a God to me. He is a person who has made a gross error of judgment following the bad advice of narrow-minded bigoted individuals and I think the Legislature ought to go on record repudiating that type of thing. If you can find anything in the resolution that is false, you ought to bring it to my attention, but you won't find a word in it which is not true.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Chambers, for your closing. The time is expiring within a minute. So the motion is to adopt this resolution. All those in favor...Senator Chambers.
