They probably won't get as good a deal on the boiler because Senator Lynch's company knows much more about the purchase of boilers and how to get the best deal than the Catholic church, but to avoid the sales tax, they will probably go out and purchase this boiler direct, have to put an additional burden on their purchasing responsibilities. For the Lutherans and the Methodists, too, Senator Higgins is taking an exception to my picking on the Catholics here.

SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

Also then the contractors, Senator Lynch's repairmen, aren't going to know when that boiler is going to be delivered, they aren't going to know...aren't going to know if they are responsible for the warranty of it or not responsible for the warranty of it.
