

SENATOR BEYER: So your answer would be that Citicorp and Sears and those institutions would be covered?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Would not be covered, they are not going to be covered by this bill, by the Kopf amendment. They are different animals than the Kopf amendment, or the committee amendment is addressing. We are basically addressing...

SENATOR BEYER: Okay, I still want to ask Senator DeCamp a question then. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR BEYER: Now you say your amendment would cover these institutions, right?

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes, sir.

SENATOR BEYER: And you agree with Senator Johnson that his bill does not cover them?

SENATOR DECAMP: I agree completely that it does not cover them. That was the point I was trying to make early on. I would further say that because of the way the Kopf system is devised it effectively, it effectively does not cover S & Ls either.

SENATOR BEYER: Okay, thank you. That's the information we needed.
