A lot of guys don't know this. He's a former flight instructor for the military. Harry would stick right solid to the ground. Senator Higgins wouldn't take off. No instruments, no nothing. You don't know where you're going or how you're going to get there. You say, the hell with it, I'm staying right here, I don't need to be in Denver because I may crash and burn otherwise.

SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Now I say before you take off you better know how you're going to get there and what you've got to get there with. I would suggest that we take a really good look at this. I know that Senator Vard Johnson has worked hard to try to put this bill together, and the Revenue Committee. They have a whole series of packages. We've gone along with some, we haven't with some, but I would hope that we would not vote blindly. I'm going to have to oppose my good friend, Senator DeCamp's, amendment because I think it would devastating to the banks in my area. I think also that we want to be certain, before we vote for 717, that it doesn't cut off, it doesn't cut off the source of capital that we need for those country banks from the large banks, and that could happen also.
