SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler, did you wish to speak? Okay. I have a few lights on. I don't know if any of you wish...Senator Vickers, please.

SENATOR VICKERS: Well, Mr. President, I would never ever think that Senator DeCamp was a fool for not objecting to something. I would certainly not agree with that at all but I would make the same point that Senator Johnson just made. Senator DeCamp, himself, in his argument for saying that it is germane admitted that 662 has two parts to it, one structure, one finance. LB 505 has only got one part. The committee amendments have only got one part. It is all finance. That was the reason that Senator DeCamp didn't fight the germaneness issue awhile ago because it correctly was all finance. This part is the other half of 662 which, obviously, was not finance. Therefore, I see no reason why it should be germane to LB 505.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp, did you wish to close on your motion please?

SENATOR DECAMP: Are you ruling? Have you ruled?

SPEAKER NICHOL: No, I was waiting for you to close and then I was going to rule. If you wish to, if you don't wish to, I will go ahead.

SENATOR DECAMP: I think it is germane, equally germane, let me put it that way.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I am going to rule that it is not germane on the grounds that LB 505 deals with finance, taxes, so forth, not school reorganization. So the other amendment was dealing with finance. This does not deal with finance or taxes. That is my reason for ruling it not germane, but I do appreciate your...
