

returns to land vary between crops. There is a high return to land of the sugar beets in Scottsbluff County. There is a low return to land of the oats in Senator Hefner's district and that will affect the income stream off an acre of land in both those two different locations. This refinement is consistent with the methodology of the bill. That is why I have co-signed the amendment and that is why I support it.

SENATOR BEUTLER: There do not appear to be any further lights on the amendment to the committee amendments. Senator Hefner, would you like to close?

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I move the Hefner-Landis amendment as it has been presented to you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, the motion before the body is the adoption of the Hefner-Landis amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Beutler voting yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Please vote. Is there anybody else who wishes to vote? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the amendment to the amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The amendment is adopted. Are there further amendments, Mr. Clerk?
