LB 196, 197
LR 242

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LR 242? If not, the motion is to adopt the resolution. All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. The motion is the adoption of LR 242 which has been under discussion and introduced by Senator Schmit. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 242.

PRESIDENT: The resolution is adopted. We next go to General File. And we are considering appropriations bills, LB 196.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 196 was introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was first read on January 15, referred to the Appropriations Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Chairman Warner of the Appropriations Committee.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move that LB 196 be advanced. As indicated by the reading of the title by the Clerk, this is the salary bill for the Legislature required to be separate by the Constitution and it merely reflects what the Constitution provides, \$4800 per year per member of the Legislature. I move it be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? If not, the motion is the advancement of LB 196. All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 196 explained by Senator Warner. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance LB 196, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: 196 is advanced. Next is LB 197.

CLERK: 197 was a bill that was introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 15, referred to the Appropriations Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Appropriations Committee amendments pending.
