LB 197, 721

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Chairman Warner of the Appropriations Committee.

SENATOR WARNER: Would you read the amendment?

CLERK: It changes, Senator, on page 3, line 11, strikes 56,128 and inserts 55,206 (sic).

SENATOR WARNER: Again, Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this is a salary bill for constitutional officers again required by the Constitution to be a separate bill. Included in that is the salary for the State Tax Commissioner who is also a constitutional officer and the committee amendment reflects the committee salary policy as that position can be adjusted during the course of the term of the individual holding it. And the amendment reflects the 3 percent salary adjustment, the total figure then being \$56,128 rather than \$55,202. I move the adoption of the committee amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the committee amendment to LB 197. Is there discussion? If not, all those in favor of adopting the amendments vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted. Now the bill, Senator.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would move that LB 197 be advanced as amended. Again, this is the appropriation bill reflecting the statutory authorized salary for constitutional officers.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on LB 197? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance LB 197, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 197 is advanced. Next, LB 721.
