

Chamber, the house is under call. There is an amendment to the appropriations bill 722 that is up for discussion. You may call in your vote to the Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Goodrich voting yes. Senator Chronister voting yes. Senator Rod Johnson voting yes. Senator Beutler voting yes. Senator Hartnett voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson, would you record your presence. Senator Chizek. Senator Chizek wants to vote.

CLERK: He has.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Seven members are excused at the present time. Members, please record your presence. Look to the board and see that your green light is on if you are in the Chamber. Members...you are there, Senator Chambers. Okay.

CLERK: Senator Chambers voting yes. Senator Beyer voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Harris, would you record your presence. Have you all voted? You may call in your vote to the Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Remmers voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Schmit amendment is adopted. Is there another amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, the next amendment I have is offered by Senator Vard Johnson. Senator Johnson is excused.

PRESIDENT: Is anyone prepared to handle the amendment that is in the file from Senator Vard Johnson? If not, it will be laid over for further consideration.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler and DeCamp would move to amend the bill. (See amendment on page 1934 of the Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Beutler. The call of the house is
