

PRESIDENT: You may call in your vote to the Clerk. Senator Morehead. There you are. You may call in your vote to the Clerk if you wish to vote on the Beutler amendment. Senator Smith. Senator Jacklyn Smith. Senator Rod Johnson, please report to the Legislative Chamber. The house is under call. The motion before you is the proposed amendment by Senator Beutler to LB 722. You still may call in your vote to the Clerk. Senator Rod Johnson, please report to the Chamber. The motion is the Beutler amendment to 722. Members may call in your votes to the Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Rupp voting yes.

PRESIDENT: A request for a roll call has been made. Very well. Members, please retain your composure and silence so that you may hear your own vote. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk. Senator...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Wait a minute. Who is here and who is not here at this point in time?

PRESIDENT: Everyone is here who is not excused.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Is Senator Abboud here?

PRESIDENT: No, he was excused about a moment ago. He is in the building I think.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, I understand he is in the building. Could we wait a few more minutes for Senator Abboud, please?

PRESIDENT: He is excused right at this desk, Senator Abboud. Somebody will have to call him. We may call the reverse order if you wish.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Could I have a reading of who is excused, Mr. Speaker, please, Mr. President?

PRESIDENT: We don't generally do that, Senator Beutler. We could report to you those people who are not here, are excused. Call the roll, Mr. Clerk, in reverse order.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on page 1935 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.
