And if you want to do a study on this, why not have it that your constituents can have these rights this summer and if there is anything that needs to be added to the Real Estate Commission's rules and regulations, Senator Barrett is very good in real estate I understand. He is very experienced. I think he would be a good one to put on that study. Senator Hannibal who makes his living selling houses and building houses, I think he'd be a good one to put on that study, but to bracket a bill to deny your constituents knowledge that they do not now have...

PRESIDENT: Your time is expiring.

SENATOR HIGGINS: ...because a certain group in the Rotunda has asked you to do that, is an untenable idea to me. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The question has been called for. Although there has not been even debate, there has been debate on both sides. I'll put the question to you. Do I see five hands for cease debate? I do. The question is, shall the debate cease? All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. The motion is to cease debate on Senator Higgins' motion to...no, on the motion of Senator Hartnett to bracket the bill. The motion now is to cease debate. Please record your vote. As you know it takes 25 votes to cease debate. If you do not wish to cease debate, we will take a vote shortly and proceed. Have you all voted? The Chair will allow 15 seconds for you to record your vote. The motion is to cease debate. Ten seconds. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.
