PRESIDENT: Senator Landis, are you going to handle Senator Withem's amendment. Senator Rupp, very well. Senator Rupp.

SENATOR RUPP: Mr. President, colleagues, Senator Withem is absent this afternoon obviously and he authorized me to handle this for him. It was adopted by the Urban Affairs Committee. I visited with Senator Higgins about this also. The Revisor did not include the wording. It is a rather technical amendment. As you can see, after the word "employee", page 24, line 5, and it simply adds the wordage "as approved by the district court." It is a noncontroversial amendment. I would urge your adoption and advancing of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Landis, do you want to make a comment? The motion is to adopt...is there further discussion? The motion is to adopt the amendment offered by Senator Rupp for Senator Withem. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote. The motion is to adopt the Withem-Rupp amendment to LB 372. Please record your vote. Have you all voted?
