PRESIDENT: Thank you. We are ready to go into Final Reading when members are in their seats. Members will please take your seats so we can begin Final Reading. May we have members in your seats, please, for the beginning of Final Reading. Okay, if we are all in our seats now, we will begin Final Reading. On the first bill, LB 279, Senator Scofield is gone and we will pass over that temporarily, and we will read first LB 97.

CLERK: (Read LB 97 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 97 pass? All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. Voting on LB 97, Final Reading. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1956 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 10 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 97 is declared passed. Next, I think we'll go back then to...Senator Scofield. We'll proceed on to LB 183.

CLERK: (Final Reading of LB 183.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 183 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on LB 183? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1957 of the Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 0 nays, 8 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient number having voted in the affirmative, LB 183 is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Next we move to LB 207. Okay, let's go
