

Polish workers who were doing slave labor for Krupp. "After speaking of the inadequate clothing, inadequate water and toilet facilities he said, "Sanitary conditions were atrocious. At Kramerplatz only ten children's toilets were available for 1,200 inhabitants. Excretion contaminated the entire floors of these lavatories. Workers were afflicted with spotted fever. Lice, the carrier of the disease, together with countless fleas, bugs and other vermin tortured the inhabitants of these camps. At times the water supply was cut off for periods of from eight to fourteen days." Some who'd think that the SS only went after the Nazis should listen to this from an eye witness and it was in the Nuremberg documents about the murder of American, Dutch and French fliers who had been captured by the SS. "The 47 officers were led barefooted to the quarry." This was at the Mauthausen concentration or extermination camp. "At the bottom of the steps the guards loaded stones on the backs of these poor men and they had to carry them to the top. The first journey was made with stones weighing about 60 pounds and accompanied by blows. The second journey the stones were still heavier and whenever the poor wretches sank under their burden they were kicked and hit with a bludgeon. In the evening 21 bodies were strewn along the road. The 26 others died the following morning." They had what they call groups, extermination groups that were attached to the German army and they were to go along and kill up any Jews that they could find, women and children. And one fellow, the Otto Olindoerf that I said was at Auschwitz, was not there, that was an error, he was the one who was the head of this group. And in his testimony at Nuremberg he was talking about the action in the Ukraine when he was attached to the 11th army and how they killed 90,000 men, women and children, not combatants, shot them down and this is what he said in response to some questions from a Russian judge at the Nuremberg trials. The Russian judge: "For what reason were the children massacred?" Olindoerf: "The order was that the Jewish population should be totally exterminated." Judge: "Were all the Jewish children murdered?" Olindoerf: "Yes." And he calmly told how they would go to a village, round up the people, make them strip off their clothing, all of their valuables, put them in trucks, take them to a ditch where the executions were to occur. And this is what he said. "Then they were shot, kneeling or standing, by the firing squads in a military manner and the corpses thrown into the ditch."
