

commissioners do a lot of other things as far as regulating the practice of law but they don't have to be lawyers. And I brought that out in telling them why then should somebody who wants to practice have to take these exams and go through the hoops they want them to jump through. So these lawyers are able to ignore these issues when it relates to their profession and it is convenient to do so. This bill as it stands will put people, and I wrote the word that Senator Beutler said, these CPA's, these people in the top part of the amendment are somewhat qualified...no, he was talking about the CPA's that didn't have to get the schooling, they are somewhat qualified for the office. They may not be as qualified as these young people who have to get the education. Well, do you want somebody who is somewhat qualified or somebody who is qualified if qualification is what you are talking about? You are not talking about qualification. You are talking about classifications and since the Legislature has chosen to take a classification for this office, I am saying you ought to go all the way with it and at least require a person to have a degree. To be a CPA you don't have to have a degree.
