

this issue before us today. But I think Senator Pappas has brought us an amendment that should strike up some thought process in our minds as far as how agriculture is administered in this state and how the University of Nebraska is working to improve agriculture in our state.

SENATOR MARSH: We are ready to vote. We are ready for Senator Pappas to close.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Madam Chairman, colleagues, after hearing the stirring opposition to my amendment by some of the leaders of the agriculture sector in the State of Nebraska, you know, senators like Senator Lamb that defends agriculture all the time and a few other ones aren't interested in helping defend agriculture and animal production in the State of Nebraska in helping them out and make sure that they get a fair shake, if they are not interested, I don't think I am and I ask withdrawal of my amendment at this time, please.

SENATOR MARSH: It is withdrawn. We are now back to the amendment offered by Senator Vickers. Would you wave your hands if you wish to speak on Senator Vickers' amendment. Senator Miller and then Senator Lamb. I'm sorry, Senator Miller, Senator Morehead had her light on first. No, she passes. Senator Miller. Thank you.

SENATOR MILLER: Madam President and members, like I said earlier this is a broader issue than what 204 encompasses. And Tom Vickers and I have talked over this bill and we have agreed to disagree on this certain point. And my position is, and I would think that we would want this body to be as effective a leader as we could be, and I think if we were as effective leaders as George Patton, we would be effective, and General George Patton said that you can tell a person what to do but don't tell him how to do it. And I believe that you should tell a person what to do, not tell him how to do it, make certain that he gets what you want done, done. I believe we don't need this kind of an amendment in this bill specifically. We already have a bill that was passed, LB 981 which was passed a year ago that does hold the person that you are telling something to get done responsible to get it done. And I would hope that we would not pass this amendment but get down to the major issue which is whether we want a vet school or not.
