SPEAKER NICHOL: Thirty seconds.

SENATOR VICKERS: That is what the amendment is saying. I think now is the time to make that choice and it seems strange to me that we have had people stand up and say, this is not germane. They know it is not germane but they haven't challenged it. They haven't challenged it because it says cooperative programs and so does the bill. That is why they haven't challenged it. It is a germane issue. It is something we had ought to do. It is something we need to do and I urge your adoption of it.
