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agreement that you're able to reach with some existing state you're going to need X amount of dollars. Admittedly, we may not be able to latch onto those federal funds if we do it that way, but I'll tell you what, I know a little something about animal clinics which is what they're talking about and you can build one heck of an animal clinic for \$14 to \$18 million. If they can't, maybe they ought to hire a different architect. I could draw one up for them that would hold a heck of a lot of animals, be a heck of a good hospital and I think I know as much about animal hospitals as anybody else in here too for that kind of money. They could do it for half the price and we all know they're going to have to because we're not going to have the funds to start spending those kinds of dollars for capital construction when we can't even come up with the funds to give them operating dollars.

SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

SENATOR VICKERS: We've got diagnostic laboratories out there right now controlled by the ag campus under the Vet Science Department that have never been fully staffed, never, ever. I wonder why. I wonder why. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I have eight speakers. Senator Rod Johnson is next, Senator Remmers, then Senator Cal Carsten. Senator Rod Johnson first.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, I will try not to take too much time. I think I appreciate as much as anybody on this floor what Senator Vickers is telling us about the fact that the dollars are not there, the commitment is not in this body to fully fund a regional vet college and he would like to have, if we are going to commit ourselves, that we should in fact have some oversight, or at least someone coming back and explaining to us exactly what we're going to get for the dollars that we commit and I can appreciate that. I think everyone in this body can appreciate the fact that we do need oversight in the way that we spend our money and of course Senator Vickers has brought to us in an amendment yesterday that was rejected by the body. If I was Senator Vickers I certainly would try and run that amendment again or at least possibly next year introduce a bill. But the problem I have is that in what Senator Vickers is telling us today is quite frankly no matter what concept the University
